

Venue Technician Job Description

About This Role

Each Venue Technician participates on a call list to assist in multiple capacities during events. Specific responsibilities are determined based on the skills of each individual. Individuals may be assigned multiple responsibilities throughout the day such as loader in the morning, stage crew in the afternoon, and operator during a performance.

Responsibilities

- 1. Installing, operating, and maintaining the audio, lighting, and video elements for a variety of multi-disciplinary events and performances.
- 2. Providing support for rehearsals and live performances in a variety of positions such as A1, A2, electrician, engineer, programmer, carpenter, and other related roles.
- 3. Supporting with the preparation, load-in, maintenance, and load-out of audio, lighting equipment, and video elements.

Commitment

- Schedule is based on availability; minimum of four-hour shifts required
- Events may require split shifts or extended days exceeding twelve (12) hours

Requirements

- Experience in technical theater or similar
- Basic knowledge of computers and audio/video equipment preferred
- Willingness to dress in black on a regular basis
- Ability to multi-task and problem solve in the moment
- Patience, adaptability, and the ability to remain calm in stressful situations
- Comfortable working both independently and in a team

<u>Environment</u>

This position may need to move frequently or stand for long periods of time. The environment requires ascending/descending ladders, ramps, and stairs. The position also must carry objects weighing up to 50 lbs. and push/pull objects weighing up to 100 lbs. on a regular basis.
