The Capitol Civic Centre, established in 1986 as a 501(c)3 nonprofit corporation, is centered around a beautifully restored former vaudeville and silent movie venue, the Capitol Theater. Originally opened on June 19, 1921, it now serves as home to an impressive array of regional performing arts organizations, as well as national touring performers, arts education activities, and civic events.
